

Carers Support Payment

Carers Allowance is being devolved to Social Security Scotland and will be known by the new name, Carers Support Payment. Carers currently in receipt of Carers Allowance will have their benefit automatically transferred over from DWP to Social Security Scotland in 2024. You do not need to take any action.

The Western Isles is one of the pilot areas for the new Carer Support Payment which was launched on Monday 20th November. As from 20th November, residents in the Western Isles looking to apply for the first time, for what was formerly called Carers Allowance will apply for Carer Support Payment. Carers wishing help to complete their form, should call Local Delivery to arrange a home visit.

Carers can apply through any of the following routes:



- Applying on-line click on this link after 8am on 20th November <u>www.mygov.scot/carer-</u> <u>support-payment</u>. The pages will have information about eligibility and will have a button which will take the applicant to the on-line application form.
- Applying via phone call Social Security Scotland on 0800 182 2222 wait for the main menu and then it's Option 4 (Carers) then 1 (Carer Support Payment). This is open this week for general queries, but, the agents will be able to take applications from 9am on Monday 20th November.
- Applying using a paper form phone Social Security Scotland on the number above on Monday 20th (or after) and we will post one out to you.
- Arranging a visit from Local Delivery phone Social Security Scotland on the number above on Monday 20th (or after) and we will sort out an appointment.

Do you have unwanted Community Equipment?

The Community Equipment Service (CES) is appealing to the public to return any unused or unwanted items. The service can collect, sanitise and repair CES supplied equipment in preparation for future use and by returning the equipment, you're not only helping other people in your community, but helping reduce our impact on the planet.

If you have equipment at your that you are not using, you can arrange a free collection by calling the Lewis & Harris CES Store on 01851 703054 or the Uist and Barra CES Store on 01870 603648.

Examples of the equipment they are looking for is shown below:

- Commodes (Wheeled & Static Commodes)
- Household Aids (Wheeled Trolleys, Kitchen Aids, Perching Stool)
- Toilet Aids (Toilet Frames & Raised Toilet Seats)
- Furniture Raisers (for Beds, Chairs and Settees)
- Bathing Aids (Bath lifts, Bath boards, Shower Stools, Shower Chairs)
- Bed Aids (Mattress Elevators, Backrests, Bedrails, Profiling Beds)
- Pressure Aids (Cushions & Mattresses)
- Mobility Aids (Walking Frames, Sticks, Crutches)
- Hoists, Slings, Slide Sheets


